



- Support the financial health of the organization, while also engaging in fundraising activities and events.
- You will attend as many board meetings as you can, in person or via phone meetings, and serve on at least one ECF committee that you feel suits your interest.

# COMMITTEES

## **Finance Committee**

The Finance Committee formulates and proposes investment and financial policies to the Jr. Board and shall implement such policies as are approved by the Jr. Board.

## **Service Committee**


The Service Committee shall assume primary responsibility for addressing the professional and family services furnished by the Foundation.

## **Development Committee**

The Development Committee shall recommend, organize and develop the Foundation's fundraising programs, policies and procedures for review by the Jr. Board; and shall oversee all fundraising activities of the Jr. Board.
